If filing a joint return, write both social security numbers on your payment in the order that they appear on the return. **Note:** The Department will not accept a check, money order, or cashier's check unless it is drawn on a U.S. (domestic) bank and the funds are payable in U.S. dollars. Please do not staple, tape, paper clip, or otherwise attach your payment or voucher to your return or to each other.
