Do not use red ink. Use blue or black ink.









Do not use dollar signs, commas, or other punctuation marks.







# **Printing**



Set page scaling to "none." The Auto-Rotate and Center checkbox should be unchecked.



Do not select "print on both sides of paper."



# **Before** Sending



Do not submit photocopies of returns. Submit originals only.



Do not mix form types.
