# November 2001 State Sales and Use Tax Report 

## IMPORTANT

Gross retail sales data included in the attached sales and use tax report for November 2001 include a portion that is estimated and may be subject to error.

Data included in the sales and use tax reports are by-product data obtained from the return-processing operation in the Department of Revenue. Nontaxable retail sales are keyed from the returns; however, taxable retail sales are computed from reported tax collections and applicable tax rates. The total of the taxable and nontaxable sales constitute the gross retail sales item shown in the report for counties, municipalities, and business classes.

On September 26, 2001, Governor Easley signed legislation increasing the state general sales and use tax rate from $4 \%$ to $4 \frac{1}{2} \%$, effective October 16, 2001.

For monthly returns, this November 2001 report includes taxes collected during the entire month of October at both the old and new rates. To approximate the correct taxable retail sales, worksheets filed with the October monthly returns were reviewed and used as the basis for computing estimated taxable retail sales. Overall, the gross retail sales data appear to be reasonable. However, caution should be used in relying on these data as indicators of business activity for county, municipal, or business groups.

MONTHLY REPORT OF STATE SALES AND USE TAX GROSS COLLECTIONS AND GROSS RETAIL SALES
Data are compiled from reports and remittances made by taxpayers, and are classified according to sales and use tax registration numbers. Detail data from this report may not be directly comparable to that in reports for other months because of corrections in registration numbers affecting collections and gross retail sales within the business, county, and city classifications, and changes in the sales and use tax law. NO county sales and use taxes are included in this report.
