Revenue Officer

The North Carolina Department of Revenue continuously recruits for Revenue Officers and will accept online applications regardless of whether or not there is a current vacancy. NCDOR has locations across the state.

Position Summary:

The primary purpose of the Revenue Officer is to answer technical tax law questions and resolve relevant issues and increase compliance by ensuring the appropriate amount of tax is reported and paid by each taxpayer. They maintain a case load of accounts for individual and businesses, who haven't paid their taxes or filed a return. The Revenue Officer determines taxpayer tax liability by examining, researching, verifying and evaluating financial statements, returns and other data. The Revenue Officer works with taxpayers to bring them into compliance or uses legal measures to collect liabilities or secure returns.
