3. *Payments of the white goods disposal tax proceeds were withheld from those local governments that, per notification from the Secretary of the NC DENR , failed to comply with the requirements of G.S. 130A-309.09A(b), 130A-309.09A(d),and G.S. 130A-309.09(B)a, as amended by S.L. 2013-360 and S.L. 2013-409, and with G.S. 130A-309.87. The withheld white goods disposal tax proceeds will remain in the General Fund.*
